

**TENNESSEE AOD TREATMENT RESOURCES SURVEY 2000**

**of Health**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services at the Tennessee Department of Health sponsored this census of alcohol and other drug treatment facilities in Tennessee. Work on the project was initiated in May 2000. The purpose of the study was to obtain up-to-date and accurate information from each identified alcohol and other drug (AOD) treatment facility in Tennessee on the types of AOD treatment offered, types of clients served, treatment utilization rates, and costs to provide AOD treatment services. Policy-makers will find this information useful in assessing gaps in services and in identifying the need for further AOD treatment resources on a county and regional level. The survey included both publicly funded and private agencies, providing public health planners with a comprehensive and timely idea of the characteristics of available AOD services.

The Community Health Research Group at The University of Tennessee in Knoxville implemented this study by compiling a list of AOD treatment providers in Tennessee, using a variety of sources. These sources included licensure and accreditation information from the Tennessee Department of Health, facilities licenses, case managers' resources directories, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Facility Finder, Yellow Pages for Tennessee, regional health and AOD service providers' lists, lists of hospital-based AOD services, and the 1997 Tennessee AOD Treatment Resource Directory. The initial list was reduced to 320 addresses by eliminating duplicate addresses and verifying that agencies and programs on the list were open and providing AOD treatment services. Focusing on treatment, agencies providing educational, referral/screening, or prevention services only were excluded.

By mid-February of 2001, CHRG had accounted for 100% of the mailing list, verifying that agencies or programs providing AOD treatment were included in the survey and those that appeared eligible but were not providing AOD treatment or those that had closed in the interim were excluded. Programs that indicated that they would soon be open and providing AOD treatment were included. Telephone interviews were conducted over a three-month period to verify responses and to follow-up. The remaining non-responding group were contacted, thereby completing data collection. About half the surveys were completed by mail or fax with telephone follow-up and the remaining surveys were completed by telephone interview. Out of 186 questionnaires completed, which represent over 230 program sites in the State, only one respondent refused an interview, and one respondent provided a partial interview. Thus, the response rate is 99%.

The data entry and analysis phase of this study began in late February, 2001, using an Access Database to input and produce the Tennessee AOD Treatment Resources Directory, an SPSS data entry screen specifically created for full data entry, and SPSS software for data analysis. Geocoding locations for mapping on the HIT Web site (server.to/hit) has been initiated. CHRГ is preparing the data for analysis and reporting on characteristics of Tennessee AOD treatment facilities in a managed care environment.

## **SELECTED STUDY RESULTS**

Prior to the TDH-CHRГ census of Tennessee AOD treatment facilities in 1997, little was known about AOD treatment resources in the State beyond those agencies and programs that were publicly funded and licensed. In order to gather descriptive information on all existing AOD treatment resources in 2000, a follow-up to the 1997 statewide survey was conducted by the Community Health Research Group, The University of Tennessee at Knoxville, under sponsorship of the Tennessee Department of Health, Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services. The survey was designed to obtain county-level information. The overall response rate was 99%. This report is a Statewide profile of types of AOD resources, treatment capacity, utilization rates and client demographics.

Survey results at the Statewide level begin with an overview of AOD treatment program types. Slightly more than half of the 93 identified AOD treatment agencies in the State receive some public funding (56%). Seventy-five percent describe themselves as non-profit, or local, state, or county government funded, or provided another characterization, such as federally-funded, or affiliated with the Department of Veteran's Affairs. Twenty-five percent of agencies describe themselves as private, for profit. Most programs are licensed by either the Tennessee Department of Health and/or the Department of Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities. A few agencies are licensed by neither (6.5%). Most agencies have one program location but some have two or more and a few have five or more. A program location is defined as a site with a unique address in which services are delivered.

The most popular type of program setting in Tennessee is free-standing facility, followed by community mental health center setting, solo or group practice, general hospital, and psychiatric hospital. The remaining setting types are community health center, correctional facility, and other specialized hospitals, and other program settings, including "Christian residential rehabilitation", "educational institution (medical college)", "transitional facilities", "human resource agencies", "homeless/battered missions", among others. The most frequently reported type of AOD treatment services offered are intensive outpatient (63% of agencies), followed closely by other outpatient treatment (61%). At least one residential form of AOD treatment is reported by more than half of agencies. Group therapy and individual counseling are the most common treatment modalities, followed by self-help/12-step

programs, family/significant other programs, milieu therapy, and other treatment modalities. Twelve-step groups are reported as a treatment option by 87% of agencies.

AOD treatment agencies provided estimates of the number of treatment beds or slots available and numbers of clients served at the county level in the past 12 months. The Statewide profile does not include analyses of information by program type or other possible dependent variables. Gross averages for the State as whole are computed using univariate analyses of central tendency. The reported average (mean) number of clients served exceeds reported program capacity at the county level in Tennessee by a ratio of approximately 5 to 1. This is much higher than the reported 3 to 1 ratio of clients served to slots available in 1997. Assuming that treatment need has remained stable since 1997, this finding is of great interest relative to the availability of treatment resources in the State. Average costs to provide treatment per day were calculated for the State as a whole, but are not broken down by program type and other variables for this report. The mean cost per day to provide treatment is \$218, with a standard deviation of \$92 and a maximum cost per day of \$4,000. The mean cost per hour to provide treatment is \$57, with a standard deviation of \$27 and a maximum cost per hour of \$127. The mean cost per visit to provide treatment is \$61, with a standard deviation of \$40 and a maximum cost per visit of \$200.

The majority of AOD treatment clients in Tennessee are male (64% averaged across facilities) and white (71%). African Americans comprise 26% of clients served with Hispanics making up 1.6% of clients. Statewide, a slightly higher percentage of Hispanic clients were reported in 2000 compared with 1997 (1%). The most frequently represented age-groups are those 25-34 (25%) and 35-44 (28%). Only 16% of clients are reported to be under age 18 and 1.8% over 65 years old. Alcohol is the most frequently abused drug of choice, representing the primary diagnosis for 42% of Tennessee clients. Cocaine is second, and marijuana, third among drugs of choice. Heroin and other opiates are the fourth most frequently abused drugs of choice. At Tennessee AOD treatment facilities in 2000, approximately half of clients on average are reported to be dependent on both alcohol and other drugs, with 26% dependent on alcohol only, and 25% dependent on drugs only.

Managed care reform significantly impacted the health care system in Tennessee in 1997, when TennCare and other variations of behavioral managed care were introduced. In 1997, nearly half of the AOD treatment agencies reported being part of TennCare, and one-third reported that they were affiliated with some other managed care organization. Two-thirds were part of the TennCare Partners, the behavioral health component of TennCare. In 2000, 30% of agencies participate in TennCare, 52% participate in TennCare Partners, and 23% report that they are affiliated with a managed care system other than TennCare.

Overall, this preliminary analysis indicates that there are no differences observed between AOD treatment facilities in 1997 and AOD treatment facilities in 2000 in terms of client demographics, treatment services provided, and preferred treatment modalities. In 2000, agencies are fewer and larger, with a much higher ratio of the numbers of clients treated in the past year to reported maximum carrying capacity, and fewer agencies participating in TennCare, TennCare Partners, and other managed care programs. Further comparative analysis with statistical significance tests are forthcoming, which will give a more in-depth perspective on the differences between the data collected on AOD treatment facilities in 1997 and 2000.
