


POPULATION AGE 65 YEARS AND OLDER BY COUNTY

Tennessee's 1996 population age 65 years and older was estimated to be 12.9 percent of the total state population. Davidson and the surrounding counties had low percentages of population age 65 years and older. Rutherford County had the lowest percentage of 8.2, while Henry County had the highest percentage of 20.2.
