

## **RESPONSIBLE SEXUAL BEHAVIOUR**

### **RESPONSIBLE ADOLESCENT SEXUAL BEHAVIOR**

(Healthy People 2010 Objective 25-11)

2010 U.S. Target: Increase to 95% the proportion of adolescents who abstain from sexual intercourse or use condoms if currently sexually active

2001 TN: 84.6% of students in grades 9 through 12 have never had sexual intercourse, or have had sexual intercourse but not during the past 3 months, or used a condom the last time they had sexual intercourse during the past 3 months

Status: Tennessee must increase by 12% the proportion of adolescents who abstain from sexual intercourse or use condoms if currently sexually active to achieve the national goal.

### **CONDOM USE BY ADULTS**

(Healthy People 2010 Objective 13-6)

2010 U.S. Target: Increase to 50% the proportion of sexually active females aged 18 to 44 who use condoms

2001 TN: Unknown. The data source is National Survey of Family Growth (NSFG), and data will not be available until 2004

Status: Unknown.

## **MENTAL HEALTH**

### **TREATMENT FOR ADULTS WITH RECOGNIZED DEPRESSION**

(Healthy People 2010 Objective 18-9b)

2010 U.S. Target: Increase to 50% the proportion of adults age 18 years and older with recognized depression who receive treatment

2001 TN: Unknown

Status: Unknown.

## **INJURY AND VIOLENCE**

### **DEATHS FROM MOTOR VEHICLE CRASHES**

(Healthy People 2010 Objective 15-15a)

2010 U.S. Target: Reduce deaths caused by motor vehicle crashes to 9.2 age-adjusted deaths per 100,000 population

2001 TN: The age-adjusted death rate (deaths per 100,000 population) from motor vehicle crashes was 22.5

Status: Tennessee must reduce the motor vehicle crash death rate by 59% to achieve the national goal.
